The original shoreline of Georges Bay can be seen in this photograph.

The wooden finger piers no longer exist and have been replaced with the main concrete wharf and bitumen waterfront.

There is now a private marina where Dance's jetty and fish processing shed once stood and the graceful wooden couter boats with crayfish pots on the open decks have been replaced with modern steel craft.
