

# Golden Fleece Bridge 1910

Compared to the photo taken in 1881, the town is now substantially bigger. The road is still unpaved of course but there are more buildings, traffic and pedestrians to be seen.

The arrows indicate the significant features of St Helens at that time.

- 1 The Schoolhouse built in 1874. It is still used today.**
- 2 Siamese Tin Mine office.**
- 3 Old Government Residence is now the site of the court house.**
- 4 Original St Helens Hotel.**
- 5 Cecilia Street, with horse traffic.**
- 6 The ship "Koomeela" that serviced St Helens on a regular basis.**
- 7 Warehouses for storing tin before shipping to Hobart, or Launceston.**
- 8 Shell Oil depot.**
- 9 Sandstone rampart from the original bridge can still be seen.**
